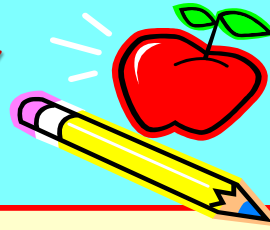


OUR WEEK IN REVIEW
