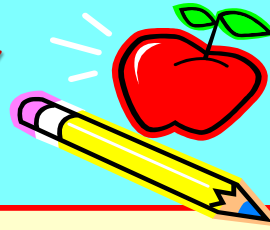


OUR WEEK IN REVIEW

We learned from this bible story that God keeps his promises.

Literacy Ideas

Here are some ideas for you to do with your preschooler when they bring home their library book.

1. Read the book together.
2. The next night let your preschooler picture read and tell you the story.
3. Do a letter hunt on several pages after you and your child read the book together. Look for our weekly focus letter. Have your child touch and tell you the letter. Ask them to find the capital letter on one page then the lower case letter on the next page. If this is difficult for your child find them together.
4. Ask your child to find different things from the pictures. Ex. Touch the red apple. Tickle the mouse on the nose. Touch the tree with your thumb. Etc.

These are just a few ideas for you to use when you are reading with your child.
