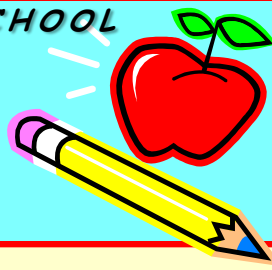

Bible Story

Our Bible Story was from John 6:1-15,
Jesus Feeds Five Thousand.

Some questions you can ask your preschooler about this week's Bible story are: Why were the people listening to Jesus? (They had heard that he healed people so they wanted to see him) Where did they sit? (On a hillside) There were so many people and they were getting? (Hungry) Were there any stores close by? (No) Were there any restaurants? (No) What did the disciples want to do? (Send the people home) What did Jesus do? (He wanted to take care of the people) The only food they could find was from? (A little boys' lunch) What was his lunch? (2 small fish and 5 small loaves of bread) Was the food enough to feed all the people? (Yes, there were even leftovers) Who cared about the people and provided even more than what the people needed to eat? (Jesus) After everyone had eaten all the food they wanted how many baskets were leftover? (12) What can we learn about this story? (Jesus is the true God and he can do miracles. It was a miracle that Jesus was able to feed all the people with just 2 fish, and 5 small loaves of bread!)

Science Fun

A few weeks ago we took water and added food coloring to it. The children predicted what would happen to the water when we put it outside for a few nights. When we looked at the containers again we learned that the water wasn't a liquid any more, it had become a solid (ice).

This week we took the ice and removed it from the containers and made predictions about what would happen if we added; sugar, cream of tartar, flour, and salt. We added each of the items then observed any changes. Then we reflected on our predictions and looked to see if any of them were what we observed. The children learned that the salt affected the ice the most. Ask your child what happened when we added each item!
