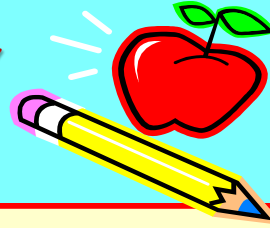


OUR WEEK IN REVIEW

Bible Story

Jacob's Lie

Some questions you can ask your preschooler are:

Who tricked Isaac? (Rebekah and Jacob)

Who did God tell Isaac to give the blessing to? (Jacob) Who did Isaac decide to give the blessing to? (Esau)

Who got the blessing? (Jacob)

Who got mad in the story? (Esau)

Who had to go live in a faraway land? (Jacob)

We learned that everyone in the story did not make good choices. They all did something wrong. We also learned that even though they all did something wrong they were forgiven. Their sins were washed away by Jesus.

Rhyming

We have just begun to work on rhyming with the children. This is a very important skill for Kindergarten readiness. I encourage you to play with rhyming at home too. Ex. Ask the question, "Hmm what rhymes with sock?" Even if it is a nonsense word, but rhymes that is acceptable as an answer. Selecting and reading books that use rhyme are also a great choice.

Focus Letter 'H'

Our focus letter was the letter 'H'. We learned that the following words begin with 'H': horse, hog, horseshoe, hat, hoe, hay, hip hop, hot, hammer, and heaven. We also learned that if you place your hand in front of your mouth when you say the letter 'H' it is hot. Ask your preschooler to show you.

We also used stampers on a large letter 'H'.

Fall Fest & Trunk-or-Treat

We are looking forward to seeing you at the Fall Festival and our 1st Trunk-or-Treat. We will have Trunk-or-Treating from 6-7 and then games and wagon rides from 7-8pm.
