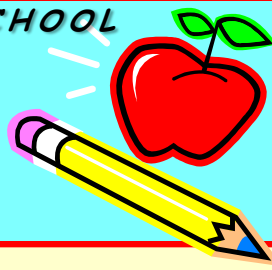

Bible Story

Our Bible Story was from Mark 10:46-52,
Jesus Heals A Blind Man

Some questions you can ask your preschooler are: Where was the blind man at? (He was on the side of the road) What was he doing? (Begging, asking for money or food) What was Bartimaeus saying? (Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me) What did the people say to him when he was calling out to Jesus? (They told him to be quiet and not bother Jesus) What did he do when they told him to be quiet? (He yelled louder to Jesus) What did Jesus do when he heard him? (He stopped and said, "Call him. Bring him over here.") What did Bartimaeus do? (He threw off his cloak and jumped up and went to Jesus) What did Jesus say to Bartimaeus? (What do you want me to do for you?) What did Bartimaeus say to Jesus? (Heal my eyes so I can see!) What did Jesus say to him? (Go your way. Your faith has made you well) Immediately Bartimaeus did what? (He opened his eyes and he could???) (See) After Bartimaeus was healed what did he do? (He became a follower of Jesus!)
