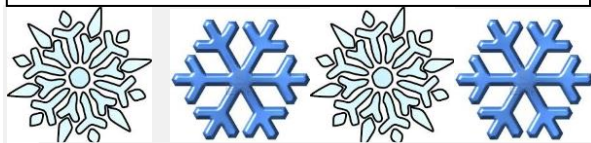

POSITIONAL WORDS & FOLLOWING DIRECTIONS

We have been focusing on positional words and following directions. We do this in so many different ways in the classroom. One of the ways is with music. We have a song by Hap Palmer called, "Circle Game." We use plastic circles that are about 20" round. The children each have one and do what the music tells them. One line is, "Can you jump inside the circle with one foot." The children are really enjoying learning the song and also following the directions while they learn positional words.

COLORS

We have also been working on colors while following directions with another Hap Palmer song. The song is titled "Colors". The children use the same circles as the "Circle Game" song. This time the children listen for the color circle they are holding to be told to stand up or sit down. They are beginning to get pretty good! Way to go Preschoolers!
