Pentecost

Our Bible Story was from Acts 2:1-14 and 38-42.

We talked about how it may have sounded when the Holy Spirit came. Ask your child about it. Some of the preschoolers were even able to connect the sound we heard when we went for our walk on Thursday, to the first Pentecost!! Way to go preschoolers!!

Some other questions you can ask your child are: After the sound of the Holy Spirit what appeared over the heads of the disciples? (Flames) What happened when the disciples started to talk? (They were speaking in different languages) Why did they start talking in different languages? (So they could spread the Good News to everyone) What happened to the hearts of 3000 people? (They were sorry for their sins and were baptized.)

Pop Can Measuring

We used pop cans to measure the preschoolers this week. They had to estimate how many pop cans tall they thought they might be. Then we measured to see the difference in their estimate.
