Daniel in the Lions Den

Our Bible Story was from Daniel 6.

Some questions you can ask your preschooler are: Who did Daniel pray to? (God) Who did the new law want Daniel to pray to for 30 days? (The king) Why did Daniel get thrown in the lions' den? (He would not pray to the king) Did the king want to throw Daniel in the lions' den? (No) When Daniel was thrown into the den what did the king say? (May your God save you?) When the king went to the lions' den the next day what did he say? (Daniel did your God save you?) Who did God send to help Daniel? (an angel) What did the angel do to the lions? (He kept their mouths closed) The king was so happy that Daniel was alive he decided he wanted the whole kingdom to love Daniel's God because he was/is the one true God!

Remember that God is with us wherever we are and we can pray to him anytime and he will take care of us.
